



Pegasus-Certified First Responder Authentication Card (FRAC)

What is a Pegasus-Certified FRAC?

- A secure, standards-based credential (ID card) authorized and managed by the responder's local agency or employer, recognizable nationwide by the Pegasus Logo on the FRAC lower left corner
- A strong, secure identity mechanism used to verify the individual holder's identity, skills and credentials recognized by emergency responders nationwide
- An attribute/certification repository allowing responders to instantly identify themselves and their capabilities in a routine or emergency response environment, including:
 - Incident Response (law enforcement & the fire service)
 - EMS/Medical/Public Health (physicians, nurses, EMTs)
 - Infrastructure Owners & Operators (e.g., school bus drivers)
 - Skilled Support Personnel (e.g., maritime equipment operators, crane and equipment operators)
 - Emergency Management Teams
- A card that certifies the cardholder's identity and credentials
- A visual ID card for use in trusted environment
- A biometrically-authenticated card readable electronically for non-trusted environments

Why is Pegasus FRAC Certification Needed?

- To provide a standard format and functionality for FRACs which may be recognized and deployed by law enforcement gatekeepers nationwide
- Enables local law enforcement gatekeepers nationwide to get ahead of the curve on emergency responder background checks and credentialing, heading off visual recognition and interoperability problems rather than fixing after the fact
- Solves the FRAC visual recognition problem
- Solves the FRAC data interoperability problem
- Recognizes Sheriffs, their law enforcement gatekeeper partners and professional licensing boards as Registrars to credential FRAC applicants and conduct background checks
- Names the Pegasus Program as the Standard Certification Authority (or SCA) to accredit Registrars and certify Vendors
- Enables any SCA-accredited Vendor to compete for the Registrar's business

What is the Pegasus-Certified FRAC Used For?

- Enables cardholders to electronically verify the identity and attributes of the cardholder so that relying parties can make informed decisions in granting/denying permissions—e.g., to verify authority to carry a weapon, or confirm completion of a background check
- When linked to Pegasus Incident Management Service and Pegasus Mutual Aid Auction Service to come, will enable NIMS-compliant incident management and after-action reports for all incident and managed sites regardless of agency affiliation, and nationwide access to mutual aid resources of cardholders and their agencies
